



New Jersey Dental Radiologic Technologist Requirements

2012 Application and Exam Fees Valid Through December 31, 2012

The New Jersey Radiologic Technology Board of Examiners (Board) licenses dental radiologic technologists in the state of New Jersey. The Board recognizes DANB's Radiation Health and Safety (RHS) examination as its licensing examination in dental radiography. This insert to the 2012 DANB CDA Exam Application Packet describes the eligibility, application and fee requirements for the examination, and the requirements for obtaining a dental radiologic technology license in New Jersey.

All individuals applying for qualification in radiography in New Jersey should read this insert carefully in order to ensure that all requirements are met.

New Jersey State Requirements

To be eligible for a dental radiologic technology license in New Jersey, candidates must:

- (1) Submit to the State of New Jersey Bureau of X-ray Compliance a complete application; **AND**
- (2) Be at least 18 years of age at the time of the application; **AND**
- (3) Be of good moral character as determined by the Board; **AND**
- (4) Successfully complete at least a high school-level education in the United States or its equivalent (such as a G.E.D. or foreign education that has been evaluated and deemed to be equivalent); **AND**
- (5) Successfully complete a 70-hour course of study in a dental radiography program approved by the New Jersey Radiologic Technology Board of Examiners or an equivalent program as determined by the Board; **AND**
- (6) Pass the national DANB Radiation Health and Safety exam (as a stand-alone exam or as part of DANB's national Certified Dental Assistant [CDA] exam).

RHS Application Requirements

Candidates who wish to take DANB's RHS Exam in New Jersey must submit:

1. A completed RHS exam application form (found on page 14 in the 2012 DANB CDA Exam Application Packet). New Jersey candidates for the RHS Exam should include their school's ID number (representing a New Jersey-approved radiology course) in the appropriate space on the application. (See Approved Schools and Programs for Dental Assistants on page 3 of this insert for school ID numbers.)

2. Payment. DANB accepts payment by check, money order or credit card (Visa, MasterCard, American Express or Discover). Check or money order payments must be payable to DANB. The application is a contract to test, and the check or credit card authorization is the contract to pay. The candidate should put his or her name on the check. DANB only accepts U.S. currency.

Exam Fees

Radiation Health and Safety Exam

Total Fee: \$175

(includes \$125 exam fee and \$50 nonrefundable application fee)

The total fee of \$175 must be paid to DANB with the initial exam application.

Exams

DANB exams are administered on computer at Pearson VUE test centers all year. The test center locations are listed on page 15 of the 2012 DANB CDA Exam Application Packet. Computerized testing allows candidates flexibility in scheduling dates and times. There are no specific exam dates or application deadlines. DANB cannot guarantee the availability of specific test center locations or times. To facilitate a time/location convenient to the candidate's schedule, call Pearson VUE promptly after receiving the *Test Admission Notice* from DANB.

If you provided DANB with your email address, you will receive email confirmation from Pearson VUE with your appointment information (date/time/location); otherwise, you will receive your Pearson VUE confirmation through regular mail. Open and read all emails/mail from Pearson VUE. There will be important information regarding your appointment.

Use the list on the next page to find the school at which the candidate completed his/her radiography course. When completing the RHS exam application (found on page 14 in the 2012 DANB CDA Exam Application Packet), insert the school's ID number in the space provided on the application.
